

TEAM SCORING AND STRUCTURE

- Organizations may register a team to compete in the triathlon Corporate Challenge. There are no additional fees required to compete as a team in the triathlon.
- Each team must have a minimum of 3 triathletes. All current employees and their spouses are eligible to participate.
- The top 3 triathletes on each team will be combined for an overall team score.
- Points will be awarded in direct correlation to the triathlete's place in his/her division. For example, 10th place will receive 10 points and 1st place will receive 1 point.
- The top 3 triathletes' standings on each team will be scored. In the event of a tie, the 4th triathlete team member will be added to the overall total for each team.
- For every \$100 raised for D.A. Blodgett - St. John's Home prior to September 8, the team can subtract 5 points from their total score. There is no contribution limit to the funds raised on behalf of D.A. Blodgett - St. John's Home.
- Teams must deliver all contributions c/o Rhoades McKee at 161 Ottawa Avenue NW, Suite 600, Grand Rapids, MI 49503. All contributions must be recorded by September 8th in order to count as a team credit.
- The team with the lowest score will win the Corporate Challenge.
- Scoring will be calculated by Classic Race Management, and the winning team will be announced at the end of the event.
- Rhoades McKee will host the winning team at a Cocktail Celebration Thursday, September 15, 2011. Location and time to be determined.
